## **SNR Recording Studio Quick-Start Guide**

- Turn on mouse, keyboard, and monitor (computer should be kept in sleep mode and not turned off)
- 2. Plug in EVO 8 Audio Interface (small black box on table, silver cord)
- 3. Sign in with your UNL login credentials
- Sign in with Adobe (use UNL login credentials all UNL faculty and staff can create a free Adobe account through the university – <a href="https://itprocurement.unl.edu/adobe-creative-cloud-full-suite">https://itprocurement.unl.edu/adobe-creative-cloud-full-suite</a>)
- 5. Plug in external drive to save your files to (do NOT leave files on the computer as they may be deleted, and your work will be lost)
- 6. Launch EVO software (use this software to centrally monitor audio levels)
  - a. Set each microphone input to "mono"
  - b. Adjust gain for each microphone to desired levels
  - c. Unplug any microphones that are not in use from the EVO 8
- 7. Launch Adobe Audition (or use the recording software of your choice)
- 8. Create new project on your external drive

- 9. Record!

## **Before You Leave**

- 1. Ensure any project files are saved to an external drive (do NOT leave files on the computer as they may be deleted, and your work will be lost)
- 2. Reset all equipment to original configuration
- 3. Unplug EVO 8 Audio Interface (silver cord)
- 4. Log out of computer (computer should be kept in sleep mode and not turned off)
- 5. Turn off mouse, keyboard, and monitor
