



## northern red oak Quercus rubra

Status: native

Code: QURU





Bark: gray/brown, smooth when young; gray with flat-topped ridges, furrowed with age Foliage: alternate, simple, lobe with bristled tips 4-8" long Twigs: slender, red/brown with lenticels & lateral buds slightly raised, terminal pointed Flower: dioecious, same tree; male catkin, long, green, numerous; female, short, fewer Fruit: acorn with shallow cap, mature in autumn after two seasons.
